## APPROPRIATIONS

### FROM GENERAL FUND

 $\star$ 

Under the State Constitution, Article IV, Sec. 21, the operating expenses of the Judicial Branch, "other than compensation to process servers and other locally paid non-judicial officers," are required to be paid from state funds. It is customary legislative practice for the General Assembly to include appropriations for the operating expenses of all three branches of state government in a single budget bill for a twoyear period ending on June 30 of the odd-numbered years. The budget for the second year of the biennium is generally modified during the even-year legislative sessions.

Facilities for the appellate courts are provided by state funds, but, by statute, the county governments are required to use county funds to provide adequate facilities for the trial courts within each of the 100 counties.
