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DEFINITIONS

Time in Court:	means time testifying or observing if asked to observe by the person requesting expert's services.
Time in Court Waiting:	means time the expert is sitting in court waiting to testify, when the expert has been called but not yet sworn in. This does not include time spent in court observing if asked to observe by the person requesting expert's services.
Time Out of Court:	means time spent reviewing files, documents or evidence; preparing for testimony; meeting with the prosecutor; or advising prosecutor on the case.
