NOTE: G.S. 15A-1029.1 allows Class H and I felonies to be transferred from Superior Court to District Court with the consent of the prosecutor and the defendant for the purpose of allowing the defendant to enter a plea of guilty or no contest. Pursuant to G.S. 7A-272(c), the District Court has jurisdiction to accept the defendant's plea of guilty or no contest when the prosecutor and defendant consent to such jurisdiction. The district attorney shall cause agreed-upon pleas to be calendared for any sessions scheduled and assigned for this purpose by the chief district court judge.
