NOTIFICATION

- ☐ You are required to maintain registration with the sheriff of the county where you reside for a period of 30 years, with an opportunity to petition in Superior Court to shorten the registration time period after 10 years, because you have been convicted of a "reportable conviction" as defined by G.S. 14-208.6(4).
- ☐ You are required to maintain registration with the sheriff of the county where you reside for your lifetime, because you have been convicted of an aggravated offense, you are a recidivist, or you are a sexually violent predator. G.S. 14-208.23.

If you intend to move to another state, you MUST report in person to the sheriff of the county of your current residence at least 3 days before the date you intend to leave this State to establish residence in another state or jurisdiction.

You can be convicted of a Class F felony (G.S. 14-208.11) if you do any of the following:

- Fail to register with the sheriff in the county where you reside or which you designated, pursuant to G.S. 14-208.8, as your expected county of residence.
- Fail to notify the last registering sheriff of a change of address.
- Fail to return a verification notice as required under G.S. 14-208.9A.
- Forge or submit under false pretenses the information or verification notices required under Article 27A of Chapter 14 of the North Carolina General Statutes.
- Fail to inform the registering sheriff of enrollment or termination of enrollment as a student.
- Fail to inform the registering sheriff of employment at an institution of higher education or termination of employment at an institution of higher education.
- Fail to report in person to the sheriff's office as required.
- Report your intent to reside in another state or jurisdiction but remain in this State without reporting to the sheriff in this State your intent to remain in the State.
- Fail to notify the registering sheriff of out-of-county employment if a temporary residence is established as required under G.S. 14-208.8A. (applies to offenses committed on or after June 1, 2007)
- Fail to inform the registering sheriff of any new online identifiers or changes to existing online identifiers.

NOTE: "Reportable conviction" means a final conviction for an offense against a minor, a sexually violent offense, or an attempt to commit any of those offenses unless the conviction is for aiding and abetting. A final conviction for aiding and abetting is a reportable conviction only if the court sentencing the individual finds that the registration of that individual under Article 27A furthers the purposes of Article 27A as stated in G.S. 14-208.5. A final conviction for a violation of G.S. 14-202(d), (e), (e1), (f), (g), or (h), or a second or subsequent conviction for a violation of G.S. 14-202(a), (a1), or (c), is a reportable conviction only if the court sentencing the individual issues an order pursuant to G.S. 14-202(l) requiring the individual to register. A final conviction for a violation of G.S. 14-43.14 is a reportable conviction only if the court sentencing the individual issues an order pursuant to G.S. 14-43.14(e) requiring

the individual to register. A final conviction in another state of an offense, which if committed in this State, is substantially similar to an offense against a minor or a sexually violent offense as defined by G.S. 14-208.6, or a final conviction in another state of an offense that requires registration under the sex offender registration statutes of that state, is a reportable conviction. A final conviction for an offense substantially similar to an offense against a minor or a sexually violent offense in a State court-martial that imposes confinement under G.S. 127A-48 or 127A-49, in a federal court-martial, or in a federal jurisdiction also is a reportable conviction. **"Offense against a minor"** means any of the following offenses if the offense is committed against a minor, and the person committing the offense is not the minor's parent: G.S. 14-39 - Kidnapping; G.S. 14-41 - Abduction of Children; G.S. 14-43.3 - Felonious Restraint.
