 Upon application for a limited driving privilege, by an applicant whose drivers license was revoked for twelve (12) months for willful refusal to submit to a chemical analysis after being charged with an implied-consent offense, the Court finds that: At the time of the refusal, the applicant held either a valid drivers license, or a drivers license that had been expired for less than one (1) year; At the time of the refusal, the applicant had not within the preceding seven (7) years been convicted of an offense involving impaired driving; At the time of the refusal, the applicant had not in the preceding seven (7) years willfully refused to submit to a chemical analysis under G.S. 20-16.2; The implied-consent offense did not involve death or critical injury to another person; The underlying charge for which the applicant was requested to submit to a chemical analysis was finally disposed of (a) other than by conviction or (b) by a conviction of impaired driving under G.S. 20-138.1 at a punishment level authorizing issuance of a limited driving privilege under G.S. 20-179.3(b), and the applicant has complied with at least one of the mandatory conditions of probation listed for the punishment level under which he/she was sentenced, or (c) by a conviction of impaired driving under G.S. 20-138.2; Subsequent to the refusal, the applicant has had no unresolved pending charges for, or additional convictions of, an offense involving impaired driving; The records of the Division of Motor Vehicles and the Clerk of Superior Court in this county have been searched, and there are no revocations in effect other than a revocation under G.S. 20-16.2 for this willful refusal, and a revocation imposed under G.S. 20-17(a)(2), for the underlying charge; The applicant has obtained a substance abuse assessment and has successfully completed any recommended training or treatment program; and has filed with the Clerk a certificate of completion; (Mandato
