I petition the Court for expunction of the juvenile records of my having been alleged to be delinquent or undisciplined as specified above, and in support of this Petition I state:

1. I was alleged to be delinquent or undisciplined in a petition filed on the date and in the case shown above.
2. The Court dismissed the juvenile petition without an adjudication that I was delinquent or undisciplined.

I request that an order be entered pursuant to G.S. 7B-3200 to expunge all records of the delinquent or undisciplined acts alleged in that Petition.

**ORDER**

The above petition under G.S. 7B-3200 was served on the chief court counselor for this district as shown in the certificate of service above, and:

- The Court finds that the petitioner satisfied the conditions of G.S. 7B-3200(h) and ORDERS that:
1. The Clerk of Superior Court and any law enforcement agency named above shall expunge all their records relating to the Juvenile Petition filed on the date shown above, including all references to arrests, complaints, referral, juvenile petitions and others.
  2. The Clerk of Superior Court shall forward a certified copy of this Order to the law enforcement agency and the chief court counselor named above, and shall send to the petitioner the notice required by G.S. 7B-3202.
- The Court finds that the petitioner does not satisfy the conditions of G.S. 7B-3200 and ORDERS that this Petition be denied.

Clerk makes three copies of this form, completes "Notice To Petitioner And Certification By Clerk" and forwards the certified copies to the law enforcement agency, the chief court counselor and the petitioner. The Clerk retains original to be disposed of with the papers in this case. No other copy is kept or made.*

- NOTES TO CLERK:**
- 1) *As soon as practical after each term of court in your county, file with the Records Officer of the Administrative Office of the Courts the names of persons granted an expunction pursuant to G.S. 7B-3200 (Send a certified copy of the Order to Attn: Records Officer, Administrative Office of the Courts, PO Box 2448, Raleigh, NC 27602, or to the same at Courier Box 56-10-50.)*
  - 2) *Upon the expunction of the juvenile's record, send written notification to the "juvenile's last known address informing the juvenile that the record has been expunged and with respect to the matter involved, the juvenile may not be held thereafter under any provision of any laws to be guilty of perjury or otherwise giving a false statement by reason of the juvenile's failure to recite or acknowledge such record or response to any inquiry made of the juvenile for any purpose except that upon testifying in a delinquency proceeding, the juvenile may be required by a court to disclose that the juvenile was adjudicated delinquent." G.S. 7B-3202.*
