## Juvenile Delinquency/Justice Calendars

Now comes the Court, by and through the Chief District Court Judge of the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, Guilford County, and finds that in the interest of justice and in accordance with North Carolina General Statue 7A-146, the calendars for Juvenile Delinquency Court should be disseminated to the District Attorney's office (assigned ADA, liaison(s), and Monica Hughes), the Public Defender's Office (assigned APDs), Court Counselor's office (including the Chief Court Counselor, all assistants and supervisors), the Supervisor/Captain in the bailiff's office, Court Appointed attorneys, and DHHS representative despite restrictions in the Rules of Recordkeeping. This order shall aid in allowing stakeholders adequate notice of the cases to be heard by the court, which promotes court efficiency and effectiveness.

It is hereby ordered pursuant to the Court's inherent authority and statutory authority for the Clerk of Guilford County to disseminate Juvenile Delinquency calendars to the District Attorney's office [assigned ADA, liaison(s), and Monica Hughes], the Public Defender's Office (assigned APDs), Court Counselor's office (including the Chief Court Counselor, all assistants and supervisors), the Supervisor/Captain in the bailiff's office, Court Appointed attorneys, and any attorney representing a juvenile as designated on the calendar.

This District Court Division of the Eighteenth Judicial District, Guilford County Administrative Order shall remain in effect until and unless it is rescinded or modified by local rules or otherwise modified.
