

AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

ASSIGNING FACILITIES FOR INITIAL TREATMENT
OF PATIENTS IN INVOLUNTARY COMMITMENT PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by North Carolina General Statutes, it is hereby ORDERED that beginning May 1, 2014, with the filing of each new petition the civil magistrates will begin alternating which facility, Carolinas Medical Center or Presbyterian Hospital, will be designated for the initial treatment of adult patients who are the subjects of commitment orders. Beginning November 1, 2014, the criminal magistrates will also begin alternating which facility, Carolinas Medical Center or Presbyterian Hospital, will be assigned for the initial treatment of adult patients who are the subjects of commitment orders.
