

ADMINISTRATIVE
ORDER


Pursuant to the North Carolina Constitution, Article IV, Section 18 and North Carolina General Statute 7A-61 and 7A-49.4, the following is adopted as the procedure for the calendaring of homicide cases in Durham County Superior Court.

All cases in which the defendant is charged with murder shall be placed on an administrative calendar before the Senior Resident Superior Court Judge for the purpose of establishing a schedule of hearing dates, trial date, assignment to a Superior Court Judge for pretrial motions and trial, or any other administrative matters. Attendance by the defendant shall not be mandatory, however, upon request, a defendant in custody will be brought to the courtroom for each hearing. These administrative calendars shall be held quarterly and shall be for the sole purpose of conducting a status conference to address administrative matters. Counsel of record will be noticed for these hearings by the District Attorney's Office, and all counsel are expected to appear as scheduled.
