## NOTICE

## THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY TO ALL PERSONS ENTERING ALL COURTROOMS

- Enter and leave the courtroom quietly.
- Maintain quiet in the courtroom and corridor area.
- Persons arriving after court convenes may be required to wait until recess to enter the courtroom.
- Chewing gum, eating, drinking, smoking, or tobacco use of any kind is PROHIBITED in all courtrooms.
- All persons should wear proper attire. No short pants, tank tops, bare feet, or clothing with vulgar language or pictures.
- Cell phones, if permitted in the courthouse, shall be turned OFF.
- Attorneys and court staff may enter and leave the courtroom as necessary unless otherwise directed by the presiding judge.
- No person may videotape, audio tape, or photograph any proceeding unless prior permission has been obtained from the presiding judge. Photographing or videotaping the juror is strictly prohibited.
- The use of profanity inside the courtroom and corridor areas is prohibited.
- All law enforcement officers and court personnel entering the courtroom shall be seated at the direction of the bailiff in charge of that courtroom.
- Counsel shall conduct themselves with dignity and respect at all times while in the courtroom.

 Only authorized court officers and/or court personnel are allowed inside the bar.
