ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
RESCINDING THE MARCH 30, 2020 ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS
RE: PAYMENT OF FINES AND FEES AND BOND FORFEITURES.

The undersigned Chief District Court Judge of Judicial District 15A enters this Administrative Order pursuant to Governor Roy Cooper declaring a statewide emergency and Chief Justice Cheri Beasley's Administrative Orders in response to the Coronavirus COVID-19.

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that on March 19, 2020 Chief Justice Beasley entered an order regarding failure to appear and failure to comply processing;

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that on April 2, 2020 Chief Justice Beasley entered an order regarding criminal monies owed;

IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Chief Justice Beasley entered an order on April 13, 2020 changing the extension period end date from April 17, 2020 to June 1, 2020;

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that the undersigned Chief District Court Judge entered an administrative order on March 30, 2020 granting an extension to pay criminal monies owed which is in conflict with the April 13, 2020 order entered by Chief Justice Beasley;

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that the undersigned Chief District Court Judge entered an administrative order on March 30, 2020 regarding an extension to comply with any bond forfeiture conditions which is in conflict with the April 13, 2020 order entered by Chief Justice Beasley;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The administrative order regarding an extension to pay criminal monies owed entered by the undersigned Chief District Court Judge on March 30, 2020 is in conflict with the order given by Chief Justice Beasley on April 13, 2020 and is hereby rescinded.
2. The administrative order regarding an extension to with bond forfeiture conditions entered by the undersigned Chief District Court Judge on March 30, 2020 is in conflict with the order given by Chief Justice Beasley on April 13, 2020 and is hereby rescinded.

3. The Alamance County Clerk of Superior Court and Alamance County District Court 15-A will be following the Chief Justice Beasley's directives. Please visit www.nccourts.gov to review all Chief Justice Beasley's orders as well as to receive any updates.
