SUPPLEMENT TO
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
DATED 03/12/2020
(FILED 03/13/2020)

THIS MATTER COMING ON BEFORE THE undersigned Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and Chief District Court Judge for Judicial District 16A; and having received and considered the recent policy adopted by Anson County (N.C.) Government that face masks or face coverings are required for entry into county buildings, the undersigned have determined in their discretion that a similar policy should apply to all individuals entering the Anson County Courthouse or judicial facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Administrative Order dated March 12, 2020 (and filed March 13, 2020) is supplemented as follows:

Those persons entering the Anson County Courthouse or any Anson County judicial facility shall wear a face mask or other face covering (to include but not be limited to scarfs, bandanas, or other coverings of the nose and mouth); and they shall continue to wear that mask or face covering for so long as they are in the building(s) that comprise the court or courthouse facilities.


Law enforcement officers shall have discretion to determine whether the face mask or face covering is sufficient to protect court or county staff, the public and the subject individuals from exposure to or spread of the coronavirus. Also, law enforcement officers are empowered to order any person entering court or judicial facilities to have his or her temperature measured. Any person refusing to allow such a test shall be

denied entry into the courthouse or judicial facility.

This Supplement to Administrative Order shall not apply to the Anson County Jail.

Except as is specifically stated herein, the Administrative Order signed March 12, 2020 and filed March 13, 2020 continues in full force and effect.
