The presence of counsel at the conference is not required. If counsel cannot be present, he or she should confer with opposing counsel and return a report of the status of the case to the Court Manager by email attachment in PDF format to:

Those who choose not to attend nor submit a report will have their case set for trial on a date determined by the Senior Resident Judge. Please note that the court will try to accommodate the date for which counsel makes a timely request; however, it is not possible to accommodate every request. Therefore, it is the responsibility of counsel to check the www.nccourts.gov website to confirm the date of his or her case that is listed on the scheduling calendar.
