The orientation program will focus on the purposes of mediation and the pursuit of the following goals:

- 1. To reduce acrimony that exists between the parties to a dispute involving custody or visitation of a minor child.
- 2. The development of custody and visitation agreements that are in the child's best interest.
- 3. To provide the parties with informed choices and, where possible, to give the parties the responsibility for making decisions about custody and visitation.
- 4. To provide a structured, confidential, nonadversarial setting that will facilitate the cooperative resolution and minimize the stress and anxiety to which the parties and especially the child are subjected.
- 5. To reduce the relitigation of custody and visitation disputes.

Upon completion of the online Orientation, you will be directed to enter your Email address and case number. This will prompt an Email to the Custody Mediation office that will confirm your completion on the online Mediation Orientation session. An online Mediation session will then be scheduled by the Mediation office and you will be notified through Email.
