DISTRICT COURT UTILIZATION PLAN FOR AUGUST 2020 FOR DISTRICT 29B – ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2020

All directives/requirements of the June 1, 2020 and July 1, 2020 Administrative Orders remain in effect except as amended below. *Pro se* matters may be scheduled in any Court except Administrative Traffic Court. The Court schedule and Judicial assignments return to the Quarterly calendar beginning August 1, 2020. Number restrictions from the June and/or July Administrative Order(s) remain in effect except as amended below. As always, thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Criminal

Pro se matters may be calendared except that no such matters may be calendared in Traffic Administrative Court. Henderson County will resume Traffic Administrative Court on Wednesdays at 2:00 pm; Polk County will have Traffic Administrative Court beginning at 9:00 am on August 6, 17 & 27; Transylvania County will have Traffic Administrative Court beginning at 9:00 am on August 3, 7 & 21. **Only** cases that have Attorneys appearing by waiver/authorization may be calendared. No *pro se* cases may be calendared. Attorneys shall notify the District Attorney of the cases the Attorney wants calendared at least 14 days prior to the scheduled Court date. The District Attorney shall notify the Clerk of Superior Court of the cases to be calendared at least 10 days prior to the scheduled Court date.

Juvenile Delinquency

All counties Delinquent Juvenile dates may have four separate calendars with calendars scheduled for 9 am, 11 am, 2 pm and 3:30 pm. Delinquent Juvenile calendars in Henderson and Transylvania Counties shall be limited to 8 Juveniles per calendar. Delinquent Juvenile calendars in Polk County shall be limited to 5 juveniles per calendar. Juvenile cases may not be carried over to another calendar unless doing so will not violate the numbers limit.

As indicated several times above, all directives of the June 1, 2020 and July 1, 2020 Administrative Orders remain effective unless expressly amended by this Order.
