## DISTRICT COURT UTILIZATION PLAN FOR JUNE 2020 FOR DISTRICT 29B – ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

**EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020**

---

All directives/requirements of the June 1, 2020 Administrative Order remain in effect except as amended below. This Order is being filed prior to June 1, 2020 and, therefore, I lack any knowledge of how effectively and efficiently June Court dates will be utilized. If I determine that particular courts have not been effectively utilized, then some of the Court designations in the attached July schedule will be subject to change. I anticipate that we will return to our regular Quarterly schedule August 1<sup>st</sup> but suspect number limitations will remain. As always, thank you in advance for your cooperation.

### Criminal

Criminal trials may be scheduled effective July 1, 2020. Otherwise, all aspects of the June 1, 2020 Order remain in effect for criminal court.

### Civil

Child Support and CVD courts may be held effective July 1, 2020. Each session of these courts shall be limited to fifteen (15) cases per session. Four sessions of these courts may be scheduled for a particular day with separate calendars schedule for 9 am, 11 am, 2 pm and 3:30 pm. No case may be “carried over” to a later calendar unless doing so will not violate the 15 case per session limitation.

The Child Support Enforcement Attorney shall be responsible for selecting the cases to be placed on the calendar for each session. The Trial Court Administrator will continue to schedule cases for CVD Court.

Henderson County Delinquent Juvenile dates may have four separate calendars with calendars schedule for 9 am, 11 am, 2 pm and 3:30 pm. Delinquent Juvenile calendars in all Counties shall be limited to eight Juveniles per calendar.


*Pro Se* cases may be calendared effective July 1, 2020.

### Small Claims

Small Claims Courts may hear any type of Small Claims action effective July 1, 2020. Numbers restrictions remain in place.

**As indicated several times above, all directives of the June 1, 2020 Administrative Order remain effective unless expressly amended by this Order.**
