COVID19 Protocol for Criminal Courtroom 1C in June 2020

- 1. In June 2020, the prosecutor will calendar cases involving felony transcripts for defendants represented by counsel. Cases that are normally handled in 2C Felony Court will be handled in 1C. In addition to these cases, you may submit a request for criminal cases to the District Attorney office one week prior to the weekly calendar. Therefore, the first deadline is May 22nd for cases to be set the week of June 1, 2020.
- 2. The time slots are from 9:00 to 11:00 am; 11:00 am to 12:30; 2:00 to 3:30; and 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm.
- 3. There will be no more than twenty defendants for each time slot. For example, from 9:00 to 11:00 am, the court will hear cases for ten defendants or less.
- 4. The District Attorney will calendar cases based on requests; available time slots; and restrictions to the number of Defendants.
- 5. Once the docket is complete, it will be posted on Juno.
- 6. The plan is to limit the number of defendants in the courtroom to ten; and to have ten defendants waiting to enter the courtroom as defendant exit the courtroom.
- 7. The Court request attorneys to practice social distancing; and to wear mask or face covering.
- 8. The Court request that Defendants wear face mask or coverings as well.
- 9. The Court will not assess a \$20.00 fee through September 2020 for Defendants if they are unable to pay on their court date.
