**DISCOVERY CONFERENCE  
ORDER**

**EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION**

**THIS CAUSE HAVING COME** before the undersigned judge presiding for a discovery conference and the Court now orders that the parties comply with the following discovery schedule:

1. The Plaintiff exchanged their Equitable Distribution Inventory Affidavit (EDIA) and attachments with the Defendant on \_\_\_\_\_.
