**ORDER RESCINDING ALL PRIOR
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS
REGARDING COVID-19**


The undersigned Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and Chief District Court Judge for Judicial District 30B under the current circumstances enter this administrative order in response to the most recent COVID-19 regulations imposed by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Governor Roy Cooper, and Chief Justice Paul Newby lifting mask requirements, capacity limits, and social distancing guidelines. Based upon the successes of minimizing health risks surrounding COVID-19 and readily accessible COVID-19 vaccinations being available

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED that:

1. Face coverings are no longer required by law for fully vaccinated persons.
2. Persons wishing to wear a face covering while conducting business inside the courthouse facilities may continue to do so.
3. All prior orders requiring capacity limits and social distancing guidelines are rescinded effective at midnight on May 18, 2021.
4. All courts will resume normal (pre-COVID-19) operations effective May 18, 2021, unless otherwise directed by the Chief Justice of the North Carolina Supreme Court.
