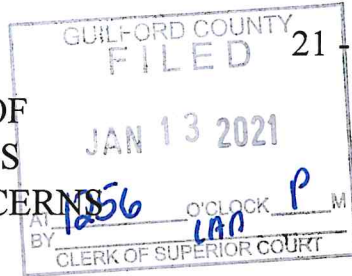

DUE TO COVID-19 CONCERNS



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Due to the marked increase in COVID-19 cases in Guilford County and the corresponding risk of increased exposure to courthouse personnel and potential jurors, the trials of all civil and criminal cases before a jury are suspended, effective immediately and continuing until March 1, 2021, whereupon this Order will expire.

The Clerk of Court is hereby directed to notify all jurors who have been summoned for duty between the effective date of this Order and March 1, 2021, that they are excused from jury duty, with the exception of regularly-scheduled and empaneled grand juries and the selection of new grand jurors. Regarding the preparation and issuance of juror summonses for court sessions on and after March 1, 2021, jurors are to be selected from the juror rolls and summoned under the usual timetables.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED.
