BY  SUPPLEMENTAL ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On April 2, 2020 Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of North Carolina determined and found that under N.C.G.S. §7A-39(b)(2) catastrophic conditions resulting from the COVID-19 outbreak continue to exist in all counties of this state. As a result, 7 Emergency Directives were issued, all of which are incorporated by reference into this county's order of March 22, 2020 and attached hereto.


It is ordered that the previous administrative order entered on March 22, 2020 shall remain in full force and effect except as countermanded by the April 2, 2020 Supreme Court Order.

The emergency directives are crucial to ensuring that our court system continues to administer justice while protecting the health and safety of court officials, court personnel and the public. Generally, in Emergency Directive 1, it was ordered that all superior court district court proceedings, including proceedings before the clerks of superior court, must be scheduled or rescheduled for a date no sooner than June 1, 2020 except under specified conditions.
