The undersigned Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and Chief District Court Judge for Judicial District 12 enter this administrative order in response to Governor Roy Cooper declaring a state of emergency to respond to coronavirus COVID-19 and the Orders Chief Justice Cheri Beasley has entered from Friday, March 13, 2020 to the present implementing measures designed to curb the spread of COVID-19 and minimize the risk of exposure caused by crowded sessions of court. The Governor has issued Executive Orders from March 14, 2020 to the present.

These orders were issued with the health and safety of all citizens in mind.

IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that after consultation with County Officials, Health Care Providers and Judicial Officials there is a need to increase protection for the health and safety of all who work or who enter the Judge E. Maurice Braswell Courthouse and anyone who attends court proceedings at the Cumberland County Detention Center from coronavirus COVID-19. This order is a supplement to the previous administrative order entered March 18, 2020.

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that requiring all who work or enter the Judge E. Maurice Braswell Courthouse for any purpose and anyone who attends court proceedings at the Cumberland County Detention Center shall be required to wear protective face covering until further notice.

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Article 1, Section 18 of the North Carolina Constitution provides: "Court shall be open. All courts shall be open; every person for an injury done him in his lands, goods, person, or reputation shall have remedy by due course of law; and right and justice shall be administered without favor, denial, or delay."


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. All who work or enter the Judge E. Maurice Braswell Courthouse and anyone who attends court proceedings at the Cumberland County Detention Center

for any purpose shall be required to wear protective face covering until further notice;

2. This administrative order shall expire when the declared state of emergency expires or upon further order of the Court.
