THIS MATTER comes before the Court on its own motion following the parties' filing of a stipulation of dismissal with prejudice as to all claims asserted in this action. (ECF No. 237.) In light of the stipulation of dismissal, the circumstances giving rise to the Court's issuance of a preliminary injunction (ECF No. 200) on 7 July 2022 no longer exist. All parties to this action have consented to the dissolution of the preliminary injunction and agree that the cash bond posted by Plaintiff John Norment ("Norment") in connection with the preliminary injunction (ECF No. 202) should be returned to Norment.

**THEREFORE, THE COURT**, in its discretion, **ORDERS** that the preliminary injunction entered on 7 July 2022 is hereby **DISSOLVED**, and the Wake County Clerk of Superior Court is **DIRECTED** to return the bond funds totaling \$10,000 to Norment.
