Overview of the North Carolina Business Court

The North Carolina Business Court ("NCBC") is an administrative designation within the Superior Court Division of the North Carolina General Court of Justice. The NCBC was established in 1996 in Greensboro, and additional courts were added in Charlotte and Raleigh in 2005. The judges currently sitting in the NCBC are Chief Judge John R. Jolly, Jr. (Raleigh), Judge James L. Gale (Greensboro), and Judge Calvin E. Murphy (Charlotte).

Pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 7A-45.4, certain cases may be designated to the NCBC as Mandatory Complex Business Cases ("Mandatory Cases"). Mandatory Cases are those actions that involve a material issue related to: (1) the law governing corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies, and limited liability partnerships; (2) securities law; (3) antitrust law; (4) state trademark or unfair competition law; (5) intellectual property law; (6) the Internet; and (7) certain areas of tax law. N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-350 further authorizes the NCBC to consider and resolve disputes concerning the rates, terms, and conditions associated with the use of poles, ducts, and conduits of communication service providers. Complex business cases and exceptional cases also may be designated and assigned to the NCBC by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of North Carolina under Rules 2.1 and 2.2 of the General Rules of Practice and Procedure for the Superior and District Courts ("Rule(s)"). A distribution of cases by case type is set forth herein.

Rule 2.1(b) requires the NCBC to issue a written opinion upon final disposition of a claim in a complex business case (which includes by definition Mandatory Cases). A list of the opinions issued by the NCBC in 2011 is included in this report. Electronic copies of the opinions are available online at www.ncbusinesscourt.net.

The NCBC utilizes electronic filing and case management systems to facilitate efficiency in litigating complex cases. Each of the three NCBC locations is equipped with a technology-enhanced courtroom for effective evidence presentation at both trials and motion hearings. The expansion of these systems and technologies allows the NCBC to provide benefits such as free public access to files, dockets, and calendars, as well as instant access to opinions and orders without the expense or delay of publication in bound volumes.

Although the NCBC is modeled after the Delaware Court of Chancery, it has become a prototype for similar courts throughout the United States. In fact, it has been dubbed "the current gold standard in established non-Delaware business courts." Anne Tucker Nees, *Make a Case for Business Courts: A Survey of and Proposed Framework to Evaluate Business Courts*, 24 Ga. St. U.L. Rev. 477 (2007).

II. Caseload Data

A. Pending and Closed Cases

The North Carolina Business Court has a total of 252 pending cases, seventeen (17) of which are on appeal and forty-one (41) of which are inactive or stayed.¹ Of the 252 pending cases, 210 are Mandatory Cases, sixteen (16) are discretionary complex business cases designated pursuant to Rules 2.1 and 2.2, and twenty-six (26) are exceptional cases assigned pursuant to Rule 2.1. 121 cases were closed in 2011.

B. Case Distribution

The North Carolina Business Court has 252 pending cases, originating from forty-three (43) counties.
