Type	Question	Response
eDiscovery	What is the bandwidth size for each attachment in eDiscovery?	Tyler Technologies has indicated that users (Law Enforcement Officer (LEO) and Prosecutor) would be able to upload multiple attachments and those attachments can be up to 5 TB and then the users upload pipe would take effect. LEOs will have their own upload pipe provided by the city / county and the Prosecutor offices will rely on the AOC eCourtNet upload pipe.
eDiscovery	How will criminal defense attorneys receive discovery from the DA's Office?	This will be accomplished via eDiscovery once it is implemented in each pilot county.
eDiscovery	How will discovery between the parties be handled, especially confidential info?	Discovery will be transmitted through eDiscovery, including Juvenile Delinquency cases.
