NOW COMES Defendant, by and through the undersigned Counsel, and moves the Court for appropriate relief. Defendant requests that the Court reopen the above-captioned case and allow for reconsideration of the imposed sentence.

In support of this Motion, Defendant offers the following:

1. Defendant was charged with second degree trespass and two counts of resisting public officer. Defendant was found guilty on all counts on 5/26/2020 by the Honorable Lunsford Long, District Court Judge presiding. Judge Long determined that a Prayer for Judgment Continued was an appropriate disposition and that he would enter the same, unless Defendant wished to appeal.
2. Defendant was represented by counsel but had not been advised on the procedure, likely outcome, or possible consequences of an appeal to Superior Court.
3. Defendant expressed a desire to appeal in open court, but did not fully understand the ramification of this decision at the time.
4. Judge Long entered judgments of costs and fines totaling \$616 and Defendant entered notice of appeal.
5. Since entering notice of appeal Defendant has consulted with Counsel and has determined that she would like to withdraw her appeal and ask the Court to reconsider sentencing.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that the Court re-open 20CR54375 and 20CR55270 for re-sentencing.


