In recognition of the urgency of the issues presented in this litigation, particularly in light of the Supreme Court's directive to this Court to resolve all claims on the merits by January 11, 2022, the Court, in its discretion, hereby **ORDERS** that the following schedule shall apply for the briefing and hearing of Legislative Defendants' motion to compel:

1. Plaintiffs in these consolidated cases may submit a written response to Legislative Defendant's motion to compel no later than 2:00 PM EST on December 15, 2021.
2. Documents should be submitted as provided in paragraph 3 of the December 13, 2021 Scheduling Order.
3. The Court will thereafter promptly rule upon Legislative Defendants' motion to compel without oral argument.

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
