¿QUÉ DEBE INCLUIR EN SU MOCIÓN DE DESACATO?

Consejos para presentar una Moción de Desacato

Para prepararse a la hora de presentar una demanda por desacato, necesita tener una copia de su orden actual. Aquí hay algunas instrucciones y una guía paso a paso para decidir si debe presentar una moción por desacato.

Paso 1: Vuelva a leer la orden judicial

Para determinar si la otra parte violó una orden judicial actual, debe volver a leer la orden judicial que cree que violó. Si no tiene una copia, haga una copia de la orden del archivo de la oficina de secretaría. Una vez que haya leído la orden actual, asegúrese de que está alegando una violación de una parte específica de la orden existente. En su moción, deberá incluir una referencia a la parte de la orden violada.

Paso 2: Desacato civil o penal

Decida si quiere perseguir el desacato civil o penal contra la otra parte.

- a. **Desacato en la Modalidad Civil:** Elija desacato civil si quiere que el tribunal obligue a la otra parte a seguir la orden existente y la otra parte tiene la capacidad de hacerlo **AHORA MISMO**. No elija el desacato civil si la violación ya ha sido completada. Se le pedirá que demuestre el desacato civil por la preponderancia de la prueba.
 - i. *Preponderancia de la prueba:* la carga de la prueba se cumple cuando la parte que tiene la carga logra convencer al determinador de hechos (Juez o Jurado) de que existe más de un 50% de posibilidades de que la afirmación sea cierta.
- b. **Desacato en la Modalidad Penal:** Elija el desacato penal si quiere que la otra parte sea castigada por violar previamente la orden actual. Se le **pedirá que demuestre** desacato penal *más allá de toda duda razonable*.
 - i. *Más allá de toda duda razonable:* Existe cuando un determinador de hechos no puede decir con certeza moral que una persona es culpable, o que existe un hecho particular.

Una vez que haya decidido si quiere perseguir el desacato en la modalidad civil o penal, marque la casilla correspondiente en la parte superior de su moción. Indique el tipo de orden que usted alega que haya sido violada (custodia, manutención de los hijos, etc.) y la fecha en que se emitió la orden original.

Paso 3: Moción

Incluya una descripción de lo que la otra parte hizo, que violó o que viola la orden judicial actual. **SEA CLARO, SEA ESPECÍFICO. ESCRIBE LEGIBLEMENTE.** Asegúrese de que esté listo/a y sea capaz de comprobar en la corte lo que alegas que hicieron para violar la orden. Incluya las violaciones que quiere que el tribunal considere. Tenga en mente que el tribunal no encontrará a la otra parte en desacato por violaciones que usted no incluyó en su Moción de Desacato.

INSTRUCCIONES PARA RELLENAR LOS FORMULARIOS

PASO 1

Rellena Los Formularios

LISTA DE COMPROBACIÓN

Debe completar los siguientes formularios:

- ❖ Acción Civil Interna (hoja principal de portada)
- ❖ Moción por Desacato
- ❖ Certificado de Servicio
- ❖ Orden de Aparecer y Mostrar la Causa
- ❖ Notificación de Audiencia
- ❖ Certificado de Servicio

Asegúrese de colocar su **número del caso existente** en la esquina superior de la derecha de cada documento. También necesitará una copia de la orden actual para adjuntarla a su moción para que el Juez la consulte. Tenga en cuenta que la moción de desacato debe ser firmada en presencia de un notario público.

PASO 2

Fotocopia de los documentos

Haga tres copias de los documentos. Las copias se pueden hacer (precio a cobrar) en la Oficina de Archivos Civiles, habitación 3342.

Después de hacer las copias, lleve el original y las tres copias al **Departamento de Archivos Civiles, habitación 3725** para ser sellado y archivado.

PASO 3

Solicitar al Juez que firme la orden de comparecencia y mostrar la causa

- ❖ Determine qué juez está asignado a su caso.
- ❖ Lleve su documento completado y la orden propuesta a la sala 8150 y colóquelo en la cesta de entrega (“*drop off*”) fuera de la sala.

- Sin embargo, si el Juez Smith es el juez asignado, lleve el documento a la sala 6350 y colóquelo en la canasta de entrega ("*Drop Off*") fuera de la sala.
- ❖ Regrese 24 horas después a la sala y recupere el documento en la canasta de recogidas ("*Pick up*").
 - ¡Compruebe que el juez haya firmado su propuesta de orden!

PASO 4

Fecha de la Audiencia

Después de recoger la orden firmada y propuesta, vaya a la **Oficina del Administrador del Tribunal de Familia, Sala 3520** para obtener una fecha de audiencia.

PASO 5

Servicio

Envíe una copia de la Moción de Desacato y de la Orden de Comparecer y Mostrar Causa, O pague al Sheriff **\$30.00** para entregar personalmente estos documentos a la parte que presenta oposición. Si decide enviar los documentos por correo, presente un Certificado de Servicio completo en la Secretaría, habitación 3725.

PASO 6

Notificación de la Audiencia

Presente la Notificación de la Audiencia con secretaría, habitación 3725. Anote lo siguiente aquí:

- ❖ Fecha de Audiencia
- ❖ Hora
- ❖ Número de la sala del tribunal

Lo recibió de la Oficina del Administrador del Tribunal de Familia.

PASO 7

Asistencia

Asegúrese de asistir a todos los eventos de la corte a tiempo y vístase apropiadamente (como si fuera a una entrevista de trabajo). Esto es muy importante.
