**Pressure Points for GOP Incumbents:**

1. Steinburg will be in a Democrat district.
2. Martin (Rep) and Butterfield (Dem) will both be in Wilson County - A Democrat district.
3. Collins will be in a leaning Republican district instead of a Republican district.
4. Sauls (Rep) and Reives (Dem) will be in the same district which is a leaning-Republican district.
5. Faircloth and Hardister will be combined in a strong Republican district in Guilford.
6. Warren (Rowan) will either be combined with Howard or Ford in a Republican district.
7. Bradford (Rep) and Beasley (Dem) are combined in a strong Rep. district in Mecklenburg.
