

Grants Management Updates 16.23 - Kristen's Updates

3/6 meeting:

- 15 agencies & 25 applications approved
 - 10 dual DV/SA
 - 4 stand alone DV
 - 1 stand alone SA

3/27 vote:

- 16 agencies & 29 applications approved
 - 13 dual DV/SA
 - 2 stand alone DV
 - 1 stand alone SA

Today's vote:

- 7 agencies & 10 applications
 - 5 dual DV/SA
 - 2 are dual agencies with only one grant ready for vote
 - 1 stand alone DV
 - 1 stand alone SA



Grants Management Updates 16.23 - Kristen's Updates

8 Remaining Agencies And 10 Applications

- •Two dual agencies who needs to write their DV grants
- •Dual agency who needs to write both grants
- •Dual agency who needs to revise both grants
- •Dual agency who needs to write SA grant
- •Dual agency who needs to revise their SA grant
- •Two stand alone DV agencies who needs to revise their grant

•Reasoning- staff shortage, needs more time, illness, emergencies, and didn't initially apply



Grants Management Updates 16.23 - Roxana's Updates

Total Approved:

• 33 agencies & 53 applications

4/24 vote:

- 6 agencies & 11 applications
 - 5 dual DV/SA agencies, 10 applications
 - 1 stand alone DV

Remaining:

- 4 agencies & 7 applications
 - 3 dual DV/SA, 6 applications
 - 1 dual DV/SA, 1 SA application

Did not apply:

• 1 stand alone SA agency did not apply

Grant Agreements:

- 50 grant agreements completed
 - 37 dual DV/SA
 - 6 stand alone DV, 5 stand alone SA
- 4 grant agreements in process
 - 2 dual DV/SA,
 - 1 stand alone DV, 1 stand alone SA

16.23 Contracts in Summary

- 3.06.23 38 approved
- 3.27.23 47 approved

Total = **107** awards approved for contract

24 awards to be voted on today

- We are working with legal for the county contracts that require multiple signatures to be added.

Discussion

Payments update

No ARPA payments have gone out;

- 1. Finance is verifying the forms for those contracts that are approved
- 2. Grants managers will be working with agencies to calculate their first payments
 - 1. Since contracts have different periods of performance, those calculations will vary from agency to agency.
 - 2. Agencies that have retroactive costs to account for will use the quarterly financial forms created to report those costs and request additional drawn downs.
