

#### **Human Trafficking Specific Funding in NC:**

SBI – 8 Positions for human trafficking

NCCWYI SeeNC Human Trafficking Program \$625k

Direct awards to the following –

WORTH Court \$300k

Cry Freedom Ministries \$250k

Rachel's Refuge \$200k



Waive Expunction Costs for Victims of Human Trafficking -

16.4(a) G.S. 15A-145.9 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(k) Costs Waived. – The costs of expunging the records shall not be taxed against the petitioner."



North Carolina Human Trafficking Commission –

- \$250k recurring operating
- \$200k nonrecurring operating
- Five separate blocks of funds to issue grants to direct service nonprofits (pages 356 – 363)



Sections Specific to Grants from the HTC:

- 1. 16.20A \$3,260,000
   Direct Service grants to 23 named agencies through an application process.
- 2. 16.20B \$1,400,000

  Pass through grants to two named agencies after proposal process

(\$220,000 of 16.20A can be used for administrative expenses related to these sections.)



Sections Specific to Grants from the HTC continued:

3. 16.21 - \$4,400,000

Competitive Grants to nonprofits through an application process.

(\$300,000 per year can be used for administrative expenses related to this section.)



Sections Specific to Grants from the HTC continued:

**4.** 16.22 – \$4,800,000

Facility Improvement grants to eligible DV/SA agencies.

\$45k cap on first round grants

Allocated in FY 2022-2023

This is the only section of the 5 that is NOT American Rescue Plan Act funds.



Sections Specific to Grants from the HTC continued:

5. 16.23 – \$15,000,000

Economic Assistance Funds to eligible DV/SA agencies.

\$7,500,000 to domestic violence organizations eligible to receive grants pursuant to G.S. 50B-9(b). Equal amounts.

\$7,500,000 to sexual assault organizations eligible to receive grants pursuant to G.S. 143B-394.21. Amount based on formula.
