# U.S. Headquarters Nashville, TN Outcomes 2021-22

- Number of people trained: 4,918 in 85 sessions
- Number of referrals received: 148
- Number of investigations: 79 cases completed
- Number of people reached through community outreach: 138
- Number of trafficking victims identified: 41

**Goal:** Contribute to the sustainable improvement of the wellbeing, safety, and self-sufficiency of survivors of human trafficking and support through community engagement and comprehensive Case Management in Charlotte and the surrounding areas.



### Outcomes

- Comprehensive, trauma-informed case management for 15 survivors (year 1)
- Community outreach to identify 20 victims (year 1)
- Build evidence base for trauma informed care services through robust MEAL
- Build capacity of service provider



Serve 8 Counties and the city of Charlotte Charlotte, Mecklenburg, Anson, Cabarrus, Gaston, Iredell, Lincoln, Rowan, and Union
