## Section 16.22 Facility Improvement Grants

- Committee has awarded all funding for this appropriation through two rounds of requests for proposals.
- Staff are currently working on contracts amendments using DocuSign.
- Target is for payment for Round 2 awards that have fully executed to be sent out before December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

## Other Updates 16.22

- Expenses reporting and performance measures forms were sent out to all grantees.
- A technical assistance webinar has been scheduled for Friday, December 9<sup>th</sup> to provide guidance to all grantees on how to complete reports and required documentation.
- Staff are completing a risk assessment tool to be used for monitoring.

## Section 16.23 Economic Assistance Funds for Organizations that Provide Services to Victims of Domestic Violence and Sexual

Assault

- 88 Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault agencies identified as eligible through the NCCWYI.
- Economic Assistance Funds can be applied as early as July 1, 2021. Grant contract end is being suggested as June 30, 2024.
- RFP released on Wednesday October 26<sup>th</sup> and applications are due via email by Wednesday December 14<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm.
- 18 Applications received to date.
