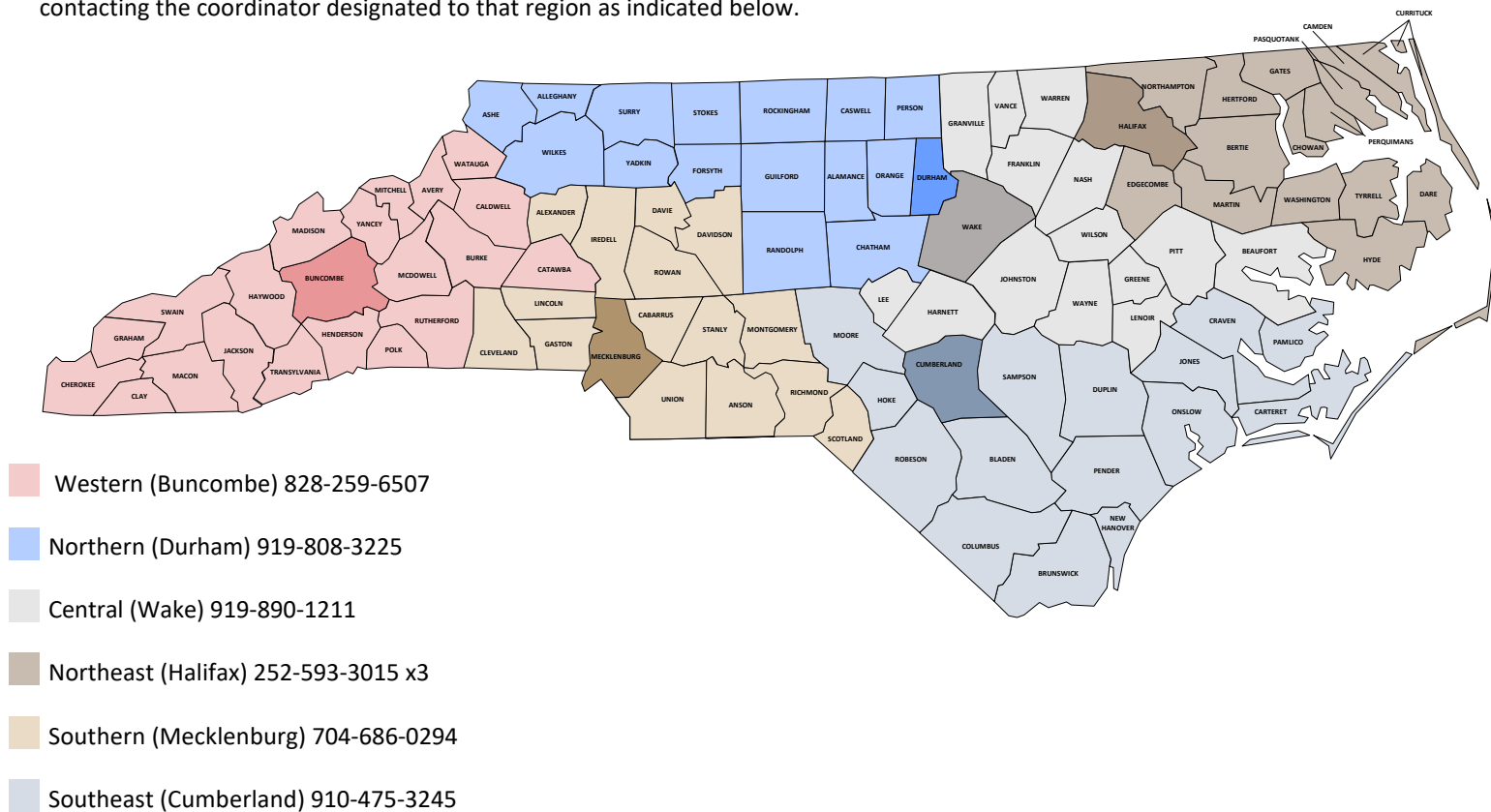




North Carolina Access & Visitation Program

The [Access & Visitation \(A&V\) Program](#) is a resource for non-custodial parents who seek access to and visitation with their children. Coordinators help identify the underlying issues creating any barriers to parenting time and facilitate non-custodial parents' access to their children. They are available on site in six counties to provide counseling, [parent education](#), and legal information about the court process as well as make referrals to community services. Parents outside those counties may receive services by phone, email, or Webex by contacting the coordinator designated to that region as indicated below.
