RESUMPTION OF JURY TRIALS

The information below is contingent upon directives of Chief Justice Cheri Beasley and Governor Roy Cooper and is subject to change at the discretion of the Senior Resident Superior Court Judge and the Trial Court Administrator (COVID-19 Coordinator) to protect the health of court personnel and of the public.

Jury trials will resume in Wake County on Monday, November 16, 2020. Court leaders consulted with local public health and county officials to develop a plan for the safe resumption of jury trials as part of the Judicial Branch's efforts to reduce the spread of COVID-19, while also ensuring our courts remain open and accessible.
