Attrition and Training


BIGGEST CHALLENGE:

 ATTRITION AND NON COMPETITIVE FORENSIC SCIENTIST PAY

JANUARY 1, 2010 - October 18, 2015

- **83** Scientist Separations:
- 42 "better employment" (50.6 %)
 - 8 -- retirement
- 18-- no reason or "personal reasons"
- 15-- miscellaneous reasons


Architectural Rendering of New Western Regional Laboratory




Report of the State Crime Laboratory Working Group: Administrative Solutions to Alleviate Lab Backlog


- Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)
 - 17 recommendations
- 26 Judicial Districts have adopted the MOA or modified MOA
- 12 are pending finalization
- 12 have made no indication to adopt
- Stop Works are addressed in 5 of 17 recommendations.
- Stop Works reduce cases and turnaround time.

TOXICOLOGY OUTSOURCING \$1.9 million available

- Have sent six batches to NMS (1009 cases)
 - 7th batch being prepared
- 18 counties currently participating
- By contract specs., 60 day turnaround time
- 3,106 Blood Drug cases & 4,169 Combo
- Testimony expense covered by DOJ

HB 357 Toxicology Reports

"§ 8-58.21. Toxicology analysis admissible as evidence in criminal prosecution in district court.

- (a) Notwithstanding G.S. 8-58.20, in any criminal prosecution in district court a laboratory report of a written toxicology analysis that states the results of the analysis and that is signed and sworn to by the person performing the analysis may be admissible in evidence without the testimony of the analyst who prepared the report provide Call ...analysis complies... with the provisions of G.S. 8-58.20/bl. the following criteria are satisfied:
- (1)
- ...analyst...complies with the provisions of G.S 35522(c) (2)
- The district attorney...[must serve a port of the lab report and affidavit and indicate whether the report and affide with be offered as evidence...]no later than 10 business days after receiving and at least 10 business days before trial.
- The defendant. as a right to appeal... for a trial de novo... (4)
- A 3? en lant reserves the right to subpoena the analyst... If the analyst fails to comply with the subpoena, and the case is not continued for the analyst to do so, the results of the analysis are inadmissible at trial in the district court.
- Nothing in this section...can violate State or federal rights...with the exception of the (c) right to a jury trial in district court.
- **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to trials commencing on or after that date.

Expunctions

Arrestee Legislation: N.C.G.S. § 15A-266.3A

- Arresting officer completes the <u>DNA Collection Form</u>.
 - Copy retained in the investigative file.
 - Copy forwarded to DA's office.
- DA has factual information in-hand of the following:
 - An arrest was made of the subject.
 - DNA sample was obtained.
- If applicable, DA should then submit an AOC form for expunction to the State Crime Lab.

(When these steps are not followed, unnecessary work is created for the State Crime Lab and the DA's office)

Completion of this form is **KEY** in the expunction process.

LEAs complete and forward a <u>copy</u> to their DA's office.
