


# **How Are State** Courts Using Data?

### Figure 2: Levels of Case Management

While the map appears to show that attorney driven civil court systems remain predominant in Pennsylvania, the results of the Statewide Civil Court Inventory Project will quickly change this view. Each county marked by a star has established a local rules committee or working group that is developing civil case management plans; most intend to implement new systems by early 2015. As new case management protocols are adopted, the map will be updated quarterly. Accordingly, both the age and size of civil inventories across the Commonwealth will change, as will the number of attorney driven systems.



### Age of Active Pending

What it is: The age of active pending cases is the average age of cases awaiting disposition.

**How it is Measured:** Case pending age is measured from the time of filing to the time of measurement. Only active cases (cases in which the court is able to proceed) are included in this measure.

Why it is Important: This measure helps the court ensure cases are disposed in a timely manner. Cases pending longer than recommended timelines may indicate the need for case management intervention.

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




# What Harris County Learned




