

# [LIVESTREAM] Nebraska vs Minnesota Live Free NCAA @Stream 16th October 2021

A Big Ten battle is on tap between the Minnesota Golden Gophers and the Nebraska Cornhuskers at 12 p.m. ET on Saturday at TCF Bank Stadium. Minnesota is 3-2 overall and 1-2 at home, while Nebraska is 3-4 overall and 0-3 on the road. These teams have met 61 times before and Minnesota leads the all-time series with 34 wins, 25 losses and two ties.

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The Cornhuskers are favored by four points in the latest Minnesota vs. Nebraska odds from Caesars Sportsbook, and the over-under is set at 48.5. What you need to know about Minnesota

The Golden Gophers were able to grind out a solid win over the Purdue Boilermakers last week, winning 20-13. Minnesota's RB Treyson Potts filled up the stat sheet, punching in one rushing touchdown along with 78 yards on the ground. He gained more yards by himself than Purdue did as a team as the Boilermakers had a total of 77 rushing yards.

This game was the third straight solid defensive effort by Minnesota, which is giving up an average of just nine points over its last three contests. Leading the defensive effort is DE Boye Mafe, who leads the Big Ten with five sacks. All five of those takedowns have come over the last three games as Mafe also has 10 total tackles and a forced fumble over that stretch.

What you need to know about Nebraska

Meanwhile, Nebraska entered its matchup against the Michigan Wolverines last Saturday without any home losses -- but there's a first time for everything. It was a hard-fought game, but Nebraska had to settle for a 32-29 loss against Michigan. Nebraska's defeat came about despite a quality game from QB Adrian Martinez, who passed for three touchdowns and 291 yards in addition to rushing for one TD and 38 yards.

Martinez is one of the most versatile players in the country and Nebraska's offense is reliant on him for success. He is the only player in the nation with at least 1,500 passing yards and 400 rushing yards. He's also a redzone threat with his legs as his 10 rushing touchdowns leads the Big Ten and ranks second in the NCAA.
